# Lot 154



**Mogck Bullseye**  
Sire of Lot 154 embryos

- Dam's Production: 2 BWR 96, 2 NR 107, 2 YR 107. She posts 1 @ IMF 109, REA 104, Rump Fat 85.
- Pathfinder® donor dam J46 is a working donor at Hoover Angus that records a 361 day calving interval which includes stealing flushes two different years! Five progeny to come to auction in past Hoover Angus sales have averaged \$13,000 – all full sibs to the embryos selling. J46's natural calves give her a record of 4-100 BWR, 4-106 NR, and 3-102 YR.
- J46 is an outstanding young cow in the Hoover herd. She is slick haired, has an excellent disposition, and a great udder. J46 has the 10th highest Docility EPD with her accuracy or better among current Angus dams! J46's superior disposition has been passed down from her dam and grandam.
- J46 produced the 3rd top selling bull in the 2015 Hoover Angus Production Sale – a full brother to the embryos selling. This bull had the top WW EPD among the 199 head of cattle that came to auction that day. He was selected by Glen Hanson for \$21,000. Another J46 son by Bullseye was a featured lot selling for \$10,750 to Larson Angus Cattle Co.
- Other J46 x Bullseye progeny have sold as follows: a feature daughter to KDS Angus for \$15,000, a son to Keller Angus Farm for \$8750, and a bred heifer daughter to Mickey Seeds for \$9500. A daughter of J46 that will have her first calf this spring at Hoover Angus was the 2nd high weaning weight heifer in the 2014 ET crop at 771 pounds.
- J46's first daughter in production has become a tremendous young cow – her first son was the 7th top-selling bull in the 2015 Hoover Angus sale at \$14,500 to Clay Howerton. Her second son was the 5th top adjusted weaning weight bull of the 2015 Hoover spring crop at 864 pounds!
- J46 had excellent performance data herself. She was the #1 adjusted weaning weight heifer calf of her crop at 790 pounds, NR 129. She went on to post a 1025 pound yearling weight, YR 111 and scan a 7.35 IMF, ratio 144, and a 9.9" ribeye, ratio 100.
- Pathfinder® grandam G205 has been a superior cow. She records 5-98 BWR, 5-111 NR, 4-102 YR, and 4-118 IMF ratio with a 357 day calving interval. Her two sons to come to auction were both photo features in past Hoover Angus sales, averaging \$7375.
- Sire Mogck Bullseye is the \$192,000 sensation best known for adding tremendous muscle and growth to his progeny. No high accuracy sire can meet or exceed Bullseye's combination of superior Docility, \$W, and \$B!
- 32 Bullseye sons in the 2015 Hoover Angus auction averaged \$10,609 and 20 yearling sons in the 2014 Hoover Angus sale averaged \$10,080! Bullseye produced the top-selling bull in Hoover Angus history, Hoover No Doubt, selling for \$67,500 to Alta Genetics, Peak Dot Ranch, and Diamond J Angus.
