

Sale, where 38 Special and his 6 flush brothers averaged \$58,928. 38 Special was the 3rd top-selling bull of the event at \$100,000, and is co-owned with Alta Genetics. Sire Commando produced 20 sons in the 2016 Baldridge sale that averaged \$35,275. 38 Special's dam has produced a total of 43 sons selling in the last three Baldridge sales to average \$38,285! There is
- ★ 38 Special was definitely the power, high performance bull of his flush and a standout with added frame in the Baldridge offering. He is a unique blend of his sire's calving ease and his dam's big frame and power.
- ★ Viewing the Y69 donor cow prior to purchasing 38 Special, we found her to be everything Jud promised. She is likely the most influential cow in Baldridge Bros. history, and is having an impact on the nation's cow herd. By the time her sons have been used heavily, Y69 will be remembered as one of the breed's great ones!
- ★ 38 Special's first calf crop was weaned in August, 2017 at Hoover Angus. They are the largest sire group, and hands down many of the finest calves that will be offered in our February 6, 2018 auction. A 38 Special heifer calf was the #1 adjusted weaning weight heifer of the crop at 872 pounds, which is the heaviest adjusted weaning weight of any female in Hoover history! Another heifer was the 4th top weaning weight heifer. 38 Special sons were the 2nd and 4th top weaning weight bull calves. 38 Special calves have added frame, length, and muscle. After his first crop, 38 Special has 49 progeny at 103 wean ratio.
- ★ Heifers were calved successfully to 38 Special, and therefore we used him much heavier on heifers during the spring and fall 2017 breeding seasons. Many bred heifers carry his service in our February sale.

Above P427 and Hoover Top Notch P409.

- ★ Top Cut's calves are low birth weight with a very solid phenotype and structural correctness.
- ★ Top Cut sired the #1 adjusted weaning weight heifer calf of the spring 2016 Hoover calf crop at 827 pounds!
- ★ Top Cut is a deep, soggy bull that serviced cows as a yearling and held his flesh well for a yearling bull.
- ★ Top Cut was our \$28,000 selection from the 2014 Bruns sale, where he was the second top-selling bull. He was the most complete, bigger framed bull we saw in 2014 and boasted a large pelvic area. ★ No Doubt is the \$67,500 top-selling bull in our 90-year history!

★ No Doubt was a hunk that turned in an adjusted 1540 pound yearling weight, ratio 113 to be the #1 adjusted yearling weight bull in our sale! He also scanned a 3.91 IMF, ratio 108, and tied as the top scanning ribeye bull (among 81 yearlings) with a 17.3" ribeye, ratio 114! No Doubt is a superb disposition bull that has the style and eye appeal everyone likes. He is exceptionally stout, and definitely puts meat and muscle in his calves. No Doubt calves have been very sound footed.

- ★ With two calf crops now weaned, we can honestly say his calves easily rise to the top. In his second crop at Hoover Angus, a flush of No Doubt sons and daughters is the highlight of the crop! A No Doubt son was the #1 adjusted weaning weight bull calf among 160 herd mates of the 2017 Hoover crop at 911 pounds! No Doubt daughters were the #2 and #3 adjusted weaning weight heifers. No Doubt's calves are stout and loaded with muscle.
- ★ Donor dam J2 was the lead-off, \$20,000 top-selling open heifer from our 2011 auction selling to KDS Angus. She was one of the most beautiful females we have ever produced. J2 is a 10th generation Hoover Angus bred, born, and raised Blackcap Ellston female.

Even more exciting is Hoover Dam's successes in carcass and feed efficiency traits. His carcass EPDs have risen significantly after calves have been ultrasounded in herds across the country. Over 6800 progeny in over 700 herds have an average 105 IMF ratio and 101 ribeye ratio. Over 100 carcass progeny have also been reported.

★ Pathfinder dam C124 has an impeccable record of 6-96 BWR, 6-114 WR, 6-106 YR, 40-101 IMF ratio and 40-102 Ribeye ratio. C124's nine sons to come to auction at Hoover Angus have averaged \$13,050 and her eight daughters have averaged \$13,475.

- ★ Elation's calves are true low birth weight, calving ease calves. A beautiful daughter in his second crop weaned at 765 pounds to be the 10th top weaning weight calf of her crop at Hoover Angus. One of Elation's first daughters to sell was sold in the Double R Angus Dispersal in Wisconsin a 7 month-old Elation daughter was the co-top selling female at \$15,000!
